



STICK & PUCK SESSIONS

Mennen Sports Arena will be offering Stick & Puck Sessions on Saturday and Sunday afternoons

Below are practices and protocols that all guests must comply with when participating in Stick and Puck Sessions at Mennen Sports Arena. Programs will continue to be modified and assessed to meet occupancy, distancing, and other requirements in accordance with CDC, local, state and federal policies and guidelines.

- Stick & Puck sessions **MUST** be purchased online due to capacity limits. The cost is \$20 per skater.
- Sessions are 1 hour in length.
- Limited to 25 skaters.
- Players must wear full equipment.
- Players must come completely dressed except for skates, helmet and gloves which can be put on in the rink.
- Each player is allowed 2 parent spectators.
- **If a player is under the age of 12 a parent chaperone must also skate on the session.**
 - The parent chaperone must pay the \$20.00 fee.
 - 1 paid parent chaperone can accompany up to 3 players under age 12.
 - Parent chaperones must wear skates, helmets and gloves. (Full equipment is preferred)
- Participants will be allowed to enter the facility 15 minutes before their session starts and be asked to leave 15 minutes after their session ends.
- ALL participants **MUST** check-in upon entry to the facility.
- Private lessons cannot take place on these sessions.
- No refunds for missed sessions.
